OFFICIAL RULES FOR RECORDING FOOTBALL STATISTICS

(Issued by the N.C.A.A. Football Rules Committee's Sub-committee on Football Statistics)

SECTION 1—FIRST DOWNS.

A first down shall be recorded whenever the yardsticks are ordered forward by the officials, and when a touchdown is scored from scrimmage (by rushing or passing) within a series of downs starting 10 yards or more from the goal line. A first down is **not** recorded on a touchdown runback, regardless of the distance of the scoring run.

SECTION 2—RUSHING.

Article 1: All offensive running plays are to be classified as rushing plays, **not** as "plays from scrimmage," since any play begun with a snapback from center actually is a play from scrimmage.

Article 2: Rushing yardage is measured from the line of scrimmage to the point where the ball is declared dead, or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble.

Article 3: The rushing total is a **net** figure. All rushing losses must be recorded so as to account for the net figure.

Article 4: All gains on lateral passes which originated or grew out of a rushing play are included in rushing yardage. (See Article 1 of Section 4.)

SECTION 3—FORWARD PASSING.

Article 1: Forward passing gains or losses are measured from the scrimmage line to the point where the ball is declared dead (or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble), so as to include both length of pass and running advance after completion. All yards gained or lost on each completed pass play are credited to **both** the passer and the receiver.

Article 2: Loss from a completed forward pass which did not advance the ball to the scrimmage line is a yardage charge against passing gain.

Article 3: Any loss by a player, apparently intending to pass, but thrown behind the line of scrimmage, is recorded as a **loss by rushing**. He is **not** a passer until he has thrown the ball, and he retains at all times the option of running.

Article 4: Interception returns are measured from the point of interception to the point where the ball is declared dead (or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble).

Article 5: There is **no** pass completed by penalty. A gain through interference on a passing play is a penalty against the defending team.

The passer is **not** charged with a pass attempt, nor credited with a pass completed or yards gained; nor is the intended receiver (or the player interfered with) credited with a pass caught. The passing team is credited only with a first down by penalty. The defensive (offending) team is charged with a penalty, and the distance from the line of scrimmage to the spot of the penalty, under "yards penalized."

Article 6: The forward passer is charged with a forward pass attempt when a forward pass is ruled intentionally grounded.

SECTION 4—LATERAL PASSING.

Article 1: A lateral pass is always a component part of the ultimate play, whether it precedes or follows that play, since the lateral is merely an extension of the original or ultimate play, in effect.

(Approved Ruling—Player A receives a forward pass for a gain of 10 yards; then throws a lateral pass to Player B, who gains an additional 5 yards. Player A is credited with one pass caught and 10 yards under "receiving". Player B is credited with **NO** pass caught and with 5 yards under "receiving". Player who threw the forward pass is credited with 15 yards under "forward passing".)

(Approved Ruling—Player A catches punt and returns 10 yards before throwing a lateral pass to Player B, who returns another 5 yards. Player A is credited with one return and 10 yards under "punt returns". Player B is credited with **NO** return and with 5 yards under "punt returns".)

Article 2: Incomplete lateral passes are scored as fumbles, and yards lost are charged against the player who, in the scorer's opinion, was responsible for the failure of the pass.

Article 3: Intercepted lateral passes are scored as fumbles, the offensive team being charged with a fumble lost.

Article 4: The official scorer rules on whether a completed pass to a flanker or man-in-motion is a forward or a lateral pass. If the latter, the play is recorded under "rushing". If the pass is incomplete, the subsequent action of the officials reveals whether the pass was a forward or a lateral.

SECTION 5—TOTAL OFFENSE.

Article 1: Total offense is the combined result of rushing and forward passing **only**, since these two are the only methods by which legal advance can be initiated while retaining possession of the ball.

Article 2: Total offense yardage is the total of **net** gain by rushing and net gain by forward passing. "Receiving" yards gained are **not** included in total offense.

FIRST QUARTER

Cornell won the toss and elected to defend the south goal. Michigan elected to receive. Van Buren kicked off for Cornell to Branoff on the Michigan 13 and he returned it to the M20.

UM: Kress ripped off a first down to the M31 on the first play of the game. Kress was piled up at the center after a two yard gain. Topor's pass to Stanford was incomplete. Branoff was tripped up after he turned his own left end for two yards. Ballings punted to D'Agostino on the C 19 and he returned it to the C 32. Whelan made three yards. Whelan picked up two more yards on a line smash. Bool's pass to Sebald was incomplete. Whelan punted from his own 36 to Branoff on the M 30, who was tackled on the M 27.

UM: Branoff was tripped up after making three yards off tackle. Kress made a first down to the M 37. Branoff broke into the open and ran nicely to a first down on the C 33. Balzhiser made one yard. Kress made two yards over guard. Kress passed to Branoff for a first down on the C 3. Kress looped a tall pass to tall Lowell Perry in the Red end zone for the TOUCHDOWN. Rescorla converted, and it was Michigan 7, Cornell 0, with 8:20s left to play.

Rescorla's squib-kick was recovered by Cornell on the C 36.

C: ~~XXXXXXXX~~ Bool's fumble was recovered on the C 25. Bool made two yards. Whelan, back to pass, changed his mind and ran up to the C 37. Whelan's punted to Oldham who was dropped immediately on the M 22.

UM: Kress went over the weak side for three yards. Balzhiser carried to the 30 but Michigan was given 15 yards for illegal use of the hands. Kress passed to Topor who ~~XXXXXXXX~~ to the M 44 for a first down. Branoff fooled nobody on a line plunge and made no yardage. Branoff ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ made four yards. Kress and Stanford got together on a nice pass play for a Michigan first down on the C 4. Kress dove over for the TOUCHDOWN. Rescorla's kick was good. MICHIGAN 14, CORNELL 0, with 3m, 43s left to play.

Rescorla kicked out of bounds. His re-kick was taken by Sebald on the 18 and he returned it to the 30. Bool recovered the fumble on the C 29. Whelan ran to the 37. Bool's fumble was recovered on the 34. Whelan's punt went to Perry on the M 30, and he was stopped on the M 25.

UM: Howell ran up to the 34. Perry made no yardage on the end around. Howell made it a first down on the M 41. Kress' pass to Topor was dropped incomplete. Balzhiser's pass to Kress went for a first down on the C 45.

END OF THE FIRST QUARTER.

SECOND QUARTER

Michigan has the ball on the C 45, with a first down. UM: Perry was brought down for a two yard loss. Howell made three yards. Topor's pass to Howell was incomplete. Billings punted out of bounds on the C 23.

C: NK 15-yard penalty against Cornell for illegal use of hands. Whelan made two yards. Sebald made six yards. Whelan punted to Oldham who was stopped on the M 47, but a 15 yard penalty was assessed against Michigan for roughing the kicker. Zatkoff recovered a Cornell fumble on the C 32.

UM: Cline passed incomplete to Topor. Cline moved down to the C 16, for a first down. Cline fumbled and Cornell recovered on the C 13.

C: Sebald ~~xxxxxxx~~ lost four yards. Whelan made two yards. Bool's pass to Cliggott was incomplete. Whelan's kick bounced dead on the C 42.

UM: Cline made five yards. Balzhiser picked off one yard. Cline carried to the 28, but a 15-yard penalty moved the ball back to the 50. Cline's pass was intercepted by Kirk who ~~xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx~~ lateralled to Hare up to the C 30.

C: Bool passed to Cliggott for a first down on the C 41. Bool's pass to Koob went incomplete. Whelan lost one yard. Bool lost five yards. Whelan punted to Oldham who booted the ball and Balog recovered on the M 47.

UM: Cline moved the ball over the midfield stripe to the C 46. Cline passed to Perry who stepped off a 35-yard gain to the C 11. Cline went over tackle for four yards. Cline lost one yard. Branoff skipped over tackle to the C 3. Cline passed to Topor for the TOUCHDOWN. Rescorla kicked the extra point. MICHIGAN 21, CORNELL 0, with 3m, 39s left to play.

Rescorla kicked off to Sebald on the C 17 and he returned it to the C 26.

C: Bool's pass to Cliggott was incomplete; Bool passed incomplete to Sebald. Whelan made no yardage. Cornell was assessed a five yard penalty. Whelan punted to Branoff on the M 36 and he returned to the ~~the~~ C 48. Cline passed incomplete to Perry. Branoff's pass to Perry was incomplete. Oldham's pass to Perry was incomplete. Billings punted from the C 49 to D'Agostino on the C 13, and he returned it to the ~~the~~ C.

Bool's pass fell incomplete. Bool lost eight yards. Whelan's pass was incomplete, but Cornell was penalized ~~xxxxxxxxxxxx~~ to the C 1, for an ineligible receiver downfield. Whelan punted.

UM: Oldham's pass to Topor was incomplete. Oldham's pass was intercepted by D'Agostino in the end zone for a touchback.

C: Cornell took over on its own 20. A five yard penalty was stepped off against Michigan. Bool passed to Kolb for a first down on the M C 36. Bool passed to Cliggott to move the ball to the C 42.

END OF THE FIRST HALF

THIRD QUARTER

Van Buren kicked off to Howell who returned to the M 17.....

UM: Branoff made six yards on a hand-off. Balzhiser's fumble was taken by ~~XX~~ who returned to the M 1. McLeod.

C: Whelan went over for the TOUCHDOWN. Van Buren's kick was good. MICHIGAN 21, CORNELL 7, with 13m, 49s left to play.

Van Buren kicked off to Howell on the M 14 and he returned it to the M 30.

UM: Oldham made five yards. ~~XXXX~~ Oldham ripped through for 15 yards and a first down on the E M 49. Branoff made one yard. Branoff picked up eight yards. Oldham made a first down on the C 36. Balzhiser twisted his way to the C 19 for a first down. Oldham lost two yards on a hand-off. Branoff regained one yard. Oldham hit Topor with a trancontinental pass play and Topor jumped into the end zone for a TOUCHDOWN. Rescorla's kick was good. MICHIGAN 28, CORNELL 7, with 9m, 11s left to play in the third quarter.

Rescorla kicked off to Sebald on the C 6 and he returned it to the C 16.

C: Bool passed to Cliggott for a nine-yard advance. Sebald punned to the C 31 for a first down. Bool's pass was incomplete. Whelan made six yards. Bool passed incomplete. Whelan punted to Branoff on the M 37 and he returned to the M 44.

UM: Fifteen yards assessed against Michigan for clipping. Howell made two yards. Topor gained one yard. Topor passed to Balzhiser for six yards. Billings punted out of bounds on the C 28.

C: Bool passed to Whelan for one yard. Bool passed to Whelan but the play lost five yards. Whelan's pass was intercepted by Tinkham who returned to the C 13.

UM: Oldham was stopped for a two-yard loss. Oldham's pass to Sanford was caught beyond the ~~xxxx~~ end zone for an incomplete pass. Oldham made six yards. Howell's pass to Perry in the end zone was batted down. Cornell took over on its nine.

C: Walters made two yards. Bool's fumble was recovered by ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ Duggar and Walker on the C 6.

UM: ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ Oldham made one yard. Michigan took an illegal use of hands penalty and set the ball back to the 16. Oldham's pass was intercepted by Kirk who returned to the C 8.

C: Whelan punted, but Cornell was offside and the ball went back to the C 3. Whelan's kick was downed by Cornell on the C 32.

UM: Oldham gained three yards. Oldham was forced out of bounds after a gain of one yard.

END OF THE THIRD QUARTER.

FOURTH QUARTER

UM: Balzhiser rammed through the line for two yards. Oldham was trapped on the C 37. Cornell took over.

C: Whelan ran for a first down on the M 37. Bool's pass to Kolb was incomplete. Bool's fumble was recovered by LeClaire on the M 37.

UM: Branoff picked up two yards. Branoff ripped through for a first down on the C 41. ~~XXXX~~ Oldham gained two yards. Balzhiser made five yards. Oldham made nothing. ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ Billings, back to punt, faked a kick and ran for a first down on the C 30. Oldham gained four yards. Balzhiser made two yards. Oldham's pass to Topor was dropped in the end zone. Oldham passed complete to Branoff on the C 4 for a first down. Oldham plunged for the TOUCHDOWN. Rescorla's kick was good. MICHIGAN 35, CORNELL 7, with 9m, 57s left in the game.

Rescorla kicked off to Sebald who returned to the C 19. Hummel received Bool's pass for a first down on C 31. Bool's pass was incomplete. Bool's pass to Kolb was incomplete. BEDROSSIAN lost one yard. Whelan punted to Perry on the M 30 and he returned to the M 45.

UM: Balzhiser went for five yards. Cline lowered his head and went through the line for a first down on the C 30. Branoff made one yard. Topor passed to Stanford for a first down on the C 22. Branoff made four yards. Cline made one yard. Fifteen yards assessed against Michigan when ~~XXXXXX~~ Cline grounded a pass. Cline's pass to Tepp was incomplete. ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ Cornell took over on the C 31.

C: Bool passed to Kolb on the C 30. Bool passed to Hummel on the C 37. Sebald made three yards. Whelan lost one yard. Whelan made no gain. Michigan took over on the C 40.

UM: McDonald in a quarter for Michigan. Cline made ~~three~~ seven yards. Beer gained not a yard. McDonald passed to ~~xxx~~ D'ngman for a first down on the C 29. McDonald lost nine yards. Howell turned end for seven yards. McDonald's pass to D'ngman was incomplete. McDonald passed to D'ngman for the TOUCHDOWN. Rescorla's kick was good. MICHIGAN 42, CORNELL 7, with 49s left to play.

Rescorla kicked off to Sebald who fumbled on the C 27, Tepp recovering.

UM: McDonald's pass to Cline was ruled complete because of interference on the C 29. Cline passed ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ to Howell, ruled complete to the C 19 because of interference. McDonald passed to Tepp for the TOUCHDOWN. MICHIGAN 49, CORNELL 7, with 1s left to play.

Rescorla kicked off. There was no time for a play.
