IU: Dozier picked up 10 yards and a first down at the I-38. Gedman gained five yards. Five yards assessed against Indiana for offside play. D'Achille's pass to Ellis was incomplete. D'Achille's pass was complete to Ellis for a first down on the M-46. Dozier made one yard. Gedman fumbled back to the M-46 and Witherspoon recovered for Michigan.

UM: Branoff gained six yards. Kress passed to Perry to give Michigan a ~~ix~~ first down on the I-43. Kress made six yards over center. Kress passed to Perry to give Michigan a first down on the I-~~17~~. Hurley bucked up to the I-15 for two yards. Branoff clicked off 10 yards on a line plunge for a first down for Michigan on the I-5. Hurley cracked over center for two yards. Kress slanted off tackle for two yards. Hurley brought the ball to within six inches of the goal. Topor quarterback-sneaked for the Touchdown. Rescorla's kick was good. MICHIGAN 7, INDIANA 0, with 6m, 49s left in the quarter.

Rescorla's kick-off was taken on the I-15 by Fisher, who returned the ball to the I-36. Dozier picked up six yards. Dozier made two more yards over center. Gedman made one yard to the I-45. Dozier made it a first down for Indiana on the M-46. D'Achille's pass to Ellis incomplete. Ashburner's long pass to Ellis was incomplete. D'Achille's pass to Zuger was incomplete. D'Achille's pass to Fisher gave Indiana a first down on the M-29. D'Achille's pass was knocked down by LeClaire. D'Achille's pass to Gedman incomplete. Gedman made it a first down up to the I-37. Ellis gained two yards. Gedman lost one yard. Kun's pass to Ellis incomplete. Helinski kicked from the I-38, to Tinkham on the M-31. ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~

UM: Branoff made two yards. Kress waded through center for five yards. Branoff swept end for 12 yards and a first down. Kress made three yards. Hurley picked up three yards. Kress passed to Perry for two yards. Topor made it a first down on the I-38. Kress picked up four yards. Branoff lowered his head and went for a first down on the I-25. Topor passed to Perry for four yards. Branoff was stopped ~~for~~ after one yard gain. Kress passed to Topor for a first down on the I-1. UM: Hurley gained one yard. Kress' pass was intercepted by Holzbach on the I-22. Ashburner passed to Borden for a first down on the I-46. Ellis' pass ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ to Ashburner incomplete.
