Minn. penalized five yards for illegal procedure; 2nd and 8 on 40

McNamara stopped by Orwig on the 44 after 4-yard-gain; 3rd and 4

Swanson fumbled, recovered his own fumble on next play; 4th and 5

Kleber punted to the Mich. 22 where the ball was allowed to roll dead; 1st and 10--Mich.

Barr ran around left end for 23 yards; 1st and 10 for Mich. on the Mich. 40

Branoff stopped by Juhl on a try around left end, gain of one; Mich was offside on the preceding play so it stood 2nd and 14;
