PRINCIPAL INDIVIDUAL PLAYS

List **all** scoring plays; also non-scoring plays (including punts) gaining 50 yards or more, and all missed field goal attempts.

Under "type of play" indicate rush, pass, int. runback, punt runback, kickoff runback, punt or field goal. List tries-for-points as P.A.T. kick, P.A.T. rush or P.A.T. pass.

On pass play, give passer first, then receiver, and combined yardage of pass and run. Measure runbacks from goal line, if started in end zone. Measure field goal attempts from point of kick. All other plays are measured from line of scrimmage.

SECTION 6 - PUNTS.

Article 1: Punts are measured from the line of scrimmage to the point of ultimate advance, if the ball remains in the field of play or goes out of bounds. (Note - "Ultimate advance" is the point where ball goes out of bounds, is downed, or is recovered by the defense.

(Note - "Ultimate advance" of the punt shall be construed to include also any distance which a receiver of the punt may retreat toward his own goal before attempting to return up field. This interpretation gives greatest benefit to both the punter and the receiver, since excellence of the punt normally is responsible for retreat by the receiver. Thus "minus yards" should NOT be recorded under "punt returns.")

Article 2: When a punt goes over the goal line (a touchback), distance of the punt is measured from the line of scrimmage to the 20-yard line **only**, since this is the limit of the punt's value to the kicking team.

Article 3: If a receiver muffs a punt and the ball **continues toward his goal line**, the punt is measured to the point of recovery or ultimate advance, as defined above. If a receiver muffs a punt and the ball bounds back **toward the kicker's goal**, the punt is measured to the point of the muff (the point of ultimate advance), and the receiver is credited with a punt return and with the yards from the point of the muff to the point of recovery, regardless of which team recovers.

Article 4: A blocked punt is recorded as a "team" entry, and not charged against the individual kicker. Thus, in the case of a blocked punt which does not pass the line of scrimmage, enter the word "team" in lieu of kicker's name and charge one punt for NO yards, so the blocked punt is **included** under "Times Kicked" in team totals.

If the ball travels toward the kicker's goal and is recovered by the **blocking** team, the yardage is treated as a punt return by the player who blocked the kick. If the ball travels toward the kicker's goal and is recovered by the **kicking** team, the yardage is treated as a punt return by the player who blocked the kick - and the blocking team is charged with a fumble lost, except on fourth down.

SECTION 7 - KICK RETURNS.

Article 1: Only the number of punts and kickoffs which the receiving team actually attempts to return are included under kick returns. (Exception - Blocked kicks which travel toward the kicker's goal. See Article 4 of Section 6.)

Article 2: The return will be measured from the point where the returning player actually gains control of the ball to the point where the ball is declared dead, or is lost by fumble. There are **no** "minus yards" under kick returns (see note under Article 1 of Section 6).

Article 3: The return of an attempted field goal, which falls short and is returned by the defending team, is treated as a punt return.

SECTION 8 - FREE KICKS.

See Official Football Statisticians Manual.

SECTION 9 - GOALS FROM THE FIELD.

Successful goals from the field are measured from the point where the ball is kicked to the goal posts (to the goal-line plus ten yards, since the goal posts are ten yards behind the goal line).

The distance of such kicks is recorded on form 347 only under "principal individual plays." If kick is unsuccessful, show yard line from which kicked, in lieu of distance.

SECTION 10 - POINTS AFTER TOUCHDOWN.

Article 1: A player attempting a try-for-point-after-touchdown by kicking is **not** charged with an attempt when a bad pass from center or a fumble by the ball holder, precludes an opportunity to kick. Such an unsuccessful attempt is charged to the "team," rather than to any individual player. However, if the ball is momentarily fumbled and then kicked, an attempt is charged to the individual kicker, regardless of the success or failure of the effort.

Article 2: The try-for-point-after-touchdown is made while time is out and is **not** recorded as a play from scrimmage (rush, pass or kick).

When a try-for-point-after-touchdown is by forward passing, the **passer** is charged (under SCORING) with the attempt, whether successful or not. If successful, the **receiver** is credited under SCORING with the conversion and points scored, and the **passer** is credited with a conversion under FORWARD PASSING.

Such a passing effort is recorded as a PAT attempt and is **NOT** recorded as a pass attempt or a pass reception.

SECTION 11 - SAFETIES.

No individual credit is recorded for any player on either team when a safety is scored. The team benefitting from the score is credited.

SECTION 12 - FUMBLES.

On any play **terminated** by a fumble, the yards involved to the point of recovery are credited or charged to the player who fumbled, regardless of which team recovers the fumble.

(Approved Ruling - On rushing play, ball carrier of Team A fumbles at the line of scrimmage and the ball travels 5 yards toward Team B goal line, before it is recovered by Team B. Player of Team A who fumbled is credited with rushing gain of 5 yards and Team A is charged with a fumble lost.)

DRESSING ROOM QUOTES FROM BUMP ELLIOTT, MICHIGAN:

"Oregon State is a good football team. The early clipping penalty gave them some momentum, and they mixed up their plays well on the touchdown drive. Our game plan called for us to go to the strong side with our running game, but then we found we had to go back the other way to make it go. We got so e momentum on Anthony's run, and that gave/ us a chance to get moving. It wasn't a new play, but we got two real good blocks from Ward and Henderson. Ward's long run also helped, of course. Things looked tough again in the second half until the blocked punt. That was a play called from ~~the~~ the bench, designed by ~~the~~ Jocko Nelson, our end coach. That was the second half spark we needed, and in a game like this sometimes once it breaks a little it can snowball. We worked harder on our punting defense than we have all year. We didn't change our defense for the second half, except for bringing our ends in a little bit tighter. We just did the things we had to do a little bit better. I understand Mel Anthony was voted player of the game, and he certainly did a great job. But I probably could name 22 others who could have gotten the award."

(NOTE: After game in dressing room, Tony Mason, offensive line coach, was asked who had been awarded the game football. He answered, "The boys voted it to Bump (Elliott), the man who deserved it.")

DRESSING ROOM QUOTES FROM TOMMY PROTHRO, OREGON STATE:

"I was disappointed in the way the team played. The offense operated as I felt it would, but the defense didn't hold up the game as we had anticipated. I thought it would be more of a defensive game. Our team was ready to play its best game, that is until after the first ~~Michigan~~ touchdown we scored. Then it seemed to let up. I didn't think the blocked punt was the turning point in the ball game. We were hurt most when we had the Wolverines on their own 15, and ahead 7-0, and then let them score a touchdown. Michigan didn't do anything different, but everything they did they did well. I was surprised with the speed of the Michigan backs after they got through the line of scrimmage. I knew before the game even started that we would be facing the best team we have played all year. Oregon State had a very good season, but I was sorry to see it end on this note. Sure, Brothers missed a few passes, and he has before, but I wasn't any more disappointed with him than the team as a whole. I came down on the field with nine minutes to go because we had put Queen (Gordon) in the game at quarterback, and he calls his own plays."

(SPECIAL NOTE: Prothro was asked about his special plans for the future, and he answered it this way (obviously the questioner was connected about the possibility of the UCLA job): "I have the same stand as I had before -- I have not even been officially contacted, I have been informally contacted but imagine most every coach in the business has been informally contacted at one time or another). The coach also said that OSU was losing a lot of good seniors, but that they also had a lot of good sophomores too.

(ANOTHER NOTE: Steve Clark wanted to sign with both the Boston Red Sox (~~Franklin~~) (baseball), and Green Bay Packers (football), but was not sure. Rich Koeper will probably sign tonight or tomorrow morning with ~~Franklin~~ either an NFL or AFL team).
