Comments by the Coa hes

Bo Schembechler of Michigan ----about Dennis Franklin " I told you guys he was a decent quarterback and that's after only 3 days of

practice after not playing 10 days....I'd say that is pretty good. He actually played better than I thought he would. Franklin bailedus out several times when we needed the yardage. He can do a lot of things. This is the kind of team we can be with him in there and this is thekind of game we want to play. In answer to a question did Franklin do a lot of the play calling himself Bo said, Franklin did a lot of the play calling and I feel his selection was very good.

I though Colorado played better than it did against LSU. They hit hard and are a very physical team. Logan is a fabulous athlete. I was very satisfied with the game.

Larry Johnson had a knee, Carl Russ and Dave Metz pinch neverse in the neck. Bo was concerned about the injuries and said, "We can't afford to lose any people. We lack depth.

Bill Lakkery Mallory of Colorado -- It was their defense. We weren't consistent on offense at all, especially on first down. But they just play great defense all the time. The punt return really hurt us.

We had to play differently after that. You have too wix when you're down an we don't play calch up football very well. When you're down you have to throw.

We are not making the rbig play offensively. With a quarterback like Franklin we expected Michigan to throw (answerring a question about Michigan's passing)

We had worked on punt coverage all week and we knew they had a pair of good kids back there, but Brown is just quite a back.
