USC vs. Michigan

Notes

USC extended its record of having won more bowl games than any team in college football history with its 16th victory today. The Trojans nowha have a 16-6 bowl record for a .727 winning percentage, the highest of the 11 major college teams that have played in at Maleast 10 bowl games.

The Pacific-8 representative has won eight of the last 10 Rose Bowl games, but the Big Ten still leads the series, 18-13, since the Rose Bowl pact was conceived in 1947.

Although playing only briefly, junior split end Randy Simmrin of USC caught one pass to extend his streak of having a reception in 2h consecutive games—since becoming a starter in the 1975 opener...Michigan, the national total offense champion with an average of hh8.l yards a game, was held to 23l yards today by the Trojan defense...USC sen or tailback Ricky Bell, leaving the game early because of a head injury, had 16 yards on four carries to fall short of Anthony Davis Pacific—8 record. Bell finished his career with 3,689 yards, second best in Eac-8 history and 35 yards behind Davis total of 3,72h.

Locker Room Quotes

JOHN ROBINSON, USC COACHE

Let's hear it for good old Vince Evans (the Player of the Game).

I thought it was one of the great football games I've been involved in. They're all great people. I believe it was also one of the toughest games. There were a lot of collisions out there. I believe we just wore them down. We simply tried to run at them and mix it up with passes.

Vince Evans played a great football games. He was super. There's nothing more pleasing to me than to say that.

Ricky Bell is one of the greatest players in southern California and in this game of football. He's also a great leader. But you win as a team---we won with all 60 of our players from the University of Southern California.

We want were never down (after Bell was murt). I don't believe in turning points. We just go out and play 60 minutes of football and see the scoreboard at the end of the game to see who won.

Evans is such a great leader, too. He rank for a touchdown and made a key first down at the end of the game to keep our drive alive. He was skew absolutely brilliant.

Michigan had the best pass defense that we played against this year. I have unlimited respect for their coaching.

(When asked about whether USC should be ranked No. % I regardless of what Pittsburgh did today) N You're damn right, I do. I still feel the way I felt before the game on that matter.
