POST GAME NOTES

DESMOND DOES IT AGAIN:

Desmond (magic) Howard accumulated 201 all-purpose yards (166 in the first quarter) and scored one touchdown en route to establishing several NCAA and Michigan records. In today's game, Howard caught four passes for 202xx 102 yards (including a 64-yard touchdown reception on a screen pass on Michigan's first offensive play of the game), rushed once for 18 yards, returned two kickoffs for 56 yards, and returned three punts for 25 yxxx yards.

NCAA RECORDS:

Howard's TD reception gives him a TD recption in nine consecutive games this season, surpassing Terry Beasley's (Auburn, 1971) and Aaron Turner's (Univ. of Pacific, xx who extended his current streak to eight games last Saturday night) streaks of eight for the NCAA record for most consecutive' regular season games in a single season with at least one TD reception. Howard has now caught at least one touchdown pass in Michigan's last 11 regular season games, dating back to last season's Minnesota game. Today, he aclipsed Mike Chronister's (BYU. 10 straight in 76-77) fames former

he eclipsed Mike Chronister's (BYU, 10 straight in 76-77) fmmx former NCAA record for Most consecutive regualr season games in a career with at least one touchdown. Today, Howard tied Aaron Turne-'s (Pacific Univ.) curretn NCAA record, set late last Saturday, of 11 straight career games with at least one TD catch. Turner plays later tonight against Fresno ST.

MICHIGAN RECORDS:
On his 64-yard TD reception Howard established two Michigan single season records. The TD gave him 120 points on the season, surpassing Tom Harmon's ****x former Michigan ****x single season scoring record of 117 points set in Harmon's Heisman-winming 1940 season. Howard's TD also gave him 20 total touchdowns this year, breaking Ron Johnson's old Michigan single season total touchdownw record of 19 set in 1968.

The tandem of Elvis Grbac and Howard tied the NCAA record for most touchdown passes throwm from the same passer to the same receiver in a career. Howard and Grbac have combined for 30 TDs in the past*** three seasons, tying the NCAA record set by Steve Ramsey and Ron Shanklin (north Texas, 1967-69). The pair have combined for 18 TDs this season, one behind the NCAA single season record for most TD passes same recevier and passer set by Andre Ware and MAnny Hazzard (19 for Houston in 1989).

POWERS CONTINUES TO STREAK:

For the third consecutive week, Ricky Powers had a multiple TD game. Powers carried the ball ten times for 81 yards and scored three TDS (on runs of two, six, and one Yards) aginst the Wildcats. Powers has scored seven TDs in his last three games (two against AMMAX Minnesota%xRMX and Purdue, three today) and his three TDs today AXMXXMX is his highest single game TD total of his career. For his career, Powers has carried the ball 340 times for 1749 yards * and 13 TDS. **Xx** Powers' 81 yards today give him 1001 **yards rushing this season, making him only the 12th player in Michigan history to rush for over 1000 yards in a single season. His 1001 rudhing yards this season are the 18th most yards gained rushing in a single season by a Michigan player.

WHEATLEY HAS CAREER DAY:
Tailback Tyrone Wheatley has the best day of his Michigan career, gaining
141 yards on nine carries and scoring 2TDS. Wheatley scored on runs'
of 29 and 74 yards (the longest run from scrimmage by a Wolverine this season.
The game was Wheatley's first ***xxx 100+ yard rushing effort of
his career and his third consecutive game with two rushing TDS..
