7 BURCH VS WARE QQ BROWN NCAA RECORDS: Desmond Howard tied two NCAA records today. Howard's two TD receptions gave him at least one TD catch in eight straight games this season, tying the NCAA record for most consecutive games with a TD catch in a season. (Terry Beasley of Auburn also caught TD passes in mix eight straight games in 1971. Howard also extended his streak of consecutive games with at least one TD maxim catch to 10 games, tying Maxim Mike Chronister's (BYU 76-77) NCAA record for most consecutive games with a % %% TD catch in a career. The xi record did does not include bowl games, so Howard's TD maxim in last year's Gator Bowl does not count toward the record.

ALL-PURPOSE MAGIC: For the ninth consecutive game, and the 16th time in his last 20 games, Howard accumulated over 100 all-purpose yards. Today, Howard had 169 all-purpose yards (seven categs for 108 yards, one rush for eight yards, and two punt returns for 53 yards). Howard caught TD passes of 47 and 17 yards, sx giving him at least two touchdowns in every game this year, and two or more receiving TDs in seven in ef eight games this year. Howard's 108-yard receiving performance is his second consecutive 100+ yard receiving performance xx and his third k game with over 100 yards receiving this season. Howard's xx two TDs today give him 19 on the season, tied with Ron Johnson (1968) for the Michigan single season total TD xxx record.

CARLSON BREAKS BIG TEN RECORD: J.D. Carlson kicked six successful extra points today, breaking the Big Ten record for consecutive successful PATs. Carlson now has made 110 straight PATs, have a whitehaux The old Big Ten record was 107 by Pete Stoyanovich in 1986-88. For his career, Carlson has kicked 121 R -ut of 123 PAT attempts, second best in Michigan history in each category behind Mike Gillete (130/133 in 1985-88).

GRBAC SETS M SINGLE SEASON RECORD: Elvis Grbac's two touchdown passes today give him 22 for the season, a new Michigan single season touchdown ex passing record. Grbac broke his own single season record of 21 set last season. For the day, Grbac completed 11 of 16 passes for 175 yards and two touchdowns. Today's game marks the seventh multiple TD passing game for Grbac this season and the sixth time in eight games that he has thrown for 175+ yards. Grbac has not thrown an interception in Michigan's last five games.

POWERS BREAKS 100: Ricky Powers carried the ball 23 times for 108 yards (5.1avg) and scored two touchdowns today. This marks the fourth time this season and the ninth time in his career that POWERS has rushed for over 100 yards in a single game. Michigan is 9-0 in games in which Powers runs for over 100 yards (4-0 in 1991 vs. Purdue, MSU, ND, and BC; 5-0 in 1990 vs. Miss., OSU, Minn., Illinois, and Wisc.). Powers' two rushing TDs mark the second consecutive game, adn the second time in his career, that Powers has scored two rushing TDs in a single game.

SHUTOUT STORY: Today's game was the first shutout since Michigan's 24-0 win over Wisconsin in 1989. The 42-point margin of victory was Michigan's largest in a shutout since a 49-0 win over Wisconsin in 1987. Michigan's last shutout of Purdue was in 1985, a 47-0 victory.

COLLETTO QUOTES (PURDUE)

"I think the defense played hard for awhile, but not for the whole game. It gets to a point defense that if the offense isn't helping you it gets hard to play."

On Michigan's defensive front - "Michigan has real good athletes, and I know I get criticized about being honest about our ability, but we're not very good up front. When it came down to having the pass and they knew it, we had a hard time making the blocks."

On Desmond Howard - "He's everything they say. He makes a catch falling down on his back and the ball is on the other side of him and he reaches back and catches it for a touchdown. I mean, he's a hell of a player."

On Michigan's offensive line - "They're a team that caeates little cracks because they're so big. They zone block you and Powers is such a strong guy that he makes six or seven yards and as you get more and more tired they'r caacks get bigger and bigger. He'll rush for 180 yards but it'll look like he didn't do much."

On Purdues starting QB Hunter - "We had some players the coaches felt should have been thrown to and weren't, but yet he dumped the ball off a few times and he hadn't done that before so that was good."

MOELLER QUOTES (MICHIGAN)

The main thing was to win and improve. The defensive improved. It was our first shutout since 1989 ... the offense sputtered in the first half but we played better in the second. I was disappointed we didn't run sharper ... it was a good football game."

On Enjuries - "Hutch (Chris Hutchinson) has a sprai ed knee. It's not as bad as we originally thought... next week (Steve) Everitt and (Burnie) Legette and Marketinkov Steve Morrison will practice, hopefully. "

On the shutout - "That was good. It's a big thing. Anytime you shutout someone it's a good feeling."
