# MPOSTSSAME COACHES QUOTES

## University of Illinois Head Coach LOU TEPPER:

On the came in general:

"This game really went the way we talked about all week. We felt that it was important to rush for over 100 yards. I told the team that if we did that we would win."

"Our mission was to make a statement. That statement is that we're a young and upcoming program in this league."

"The turnovers certainly kept us in the game early. Michigan dominated the first quarter, but I think in the second-half our players really believed they could win."

On the tie:

"The tie certainly helped us more than it helped them ... I thought it was a hard call, but the tie puts them in better Rose Bowl position."

"We're not at the same level (as Michigan), but I think our piayers are competing at that level ... From the second quarter on I think we went toe-to-toe with Michigan."

On the two-point conversion (score 19-15):

"I wasn't surprised that they went for two, that's a call that can go either way."

Illinois Quarterback Jason Verduzco:

"It felt good that we were going with one of the best teams in the country and staying with them."

On his (Verduzco's) final touchdown:

"The goal line was there and it was just me and the other guy ... They (Michigan) came down and made a long drive, and we knew we had to come back and score."

Illinois Fullback Darren Boyer:

"You put 11 guys on the field and anything can happen."

Illinois Offensive Tackle Brad Hopkins:

"We didn't hurt our bowl chances by tying Michigan. Regardless of what happened today, Michigan is still an outstanding defense ... That Michigan didn't do well today is not the case, we played a good game today."

#### University of Michigan Head Coach GARY MOELLER:

On the win, in general:

"It's a sad way to get yourself invited to a big party. We went out and self-destructed (the offense). The defense played well in the first half, but didn't do the things we had to do to win."

On the ten fumbles:

"How sickening, very disappointing."

On the comeback

"Elvis came back with a late drive, and the offensive line played pretty well; you don't have a comeback drive without protection. I was proud of the way we kicked the field goal. Pete (Elezovic) did an excellent job under pressure."

The thinking behind the last four plays before the tying field goal:

"it was the same thing I thought about last week, I thought about it last night, and with six or seven minutes left in the game: get the ball, and move it into field goal position. You don't risk winning the Big Ten title outright and going to the Rose Bowl the best way. You get down there and get in position for the field goal."

On the play of Jason Verduzco:

"They have a good attack, and he played it very well. Obviously he's done that on several occasions, give him credit for that."

On Michigan-Ohio State:

"We're gonna play hard and they will too. It is still Ohio State-Michigan and we're proud to be part of it."

### Michigan vs. Illinois POST-GAME NOTES

Michigan Sets New NCAA Single Season Average Attendance Record

With today's crowd of 106.481, Michigan established a new NCAA single season average attendance record with a season average attendance of 105,700 (634,201 total attendance in six home games this season). Michigan set the old record in 1985, when 633,530 fans attended six home games for a 105,588 average. The single season average attendance record is the second NCAA attendance record Michigan has set this season, the other being the NCAA single game attendance record set by Michigan's 106,788 crowd against Michigan State earlier this season. Today's crowd was the 109th straight 100,000+ crowd at Michigan Stadium.

Wolverines Clinch Rose Outright Big Ten Title and Rose Bowl Berth

Michigan's tie with Illinois gave Michigan its second straight outright Big Ten championship and second consecutive Rose Bowl berth. Michigan has now won five straight Big Ten championships, has posted four outright Big Ten titles in five years, and has earned four Rose Bowl berths in the last five seasons. Michigan has played in 15 Rose Bowls, the most of any Big Ten team, and has won 37 Big Ten football championships, the most of any conference school. Michigan now has two ties this season, the first time that has happened since the Wolverines tied Stanford (19-19) and Baylor (14-14) back-to-back in 1975.

Grbac Breaks 6,000

Elvis Grbac completed 21 of 29 passes (72% complete) for 278 yards and one touchdown to lift him him past 6,000 career passing yards. Grbac, the first Michigan quarterback and 13th Big Ten quarterback to pass for over 6,000 yards, has completed 504 of 803 passes (63 % complete) for 6276 yards and 69 touchdowns.

Johnson Rolls It Up

Jesse Johnson led Michigan's rushing attack with 121 yards and two touchdowns on on 23 carries.

Johnson's performance was his second 100+ yard rushing effort in the last three games (118 yards at Purdue) and was the fourth 100+ yard rushing yard performance of his career (104 yards at Illinois and 168 yards at Iowa last season). Johnson now has 727 yards and four touchdowns on 142 carries this season and 1396 yards and 10 touchdowns on 260 carries in his career.

Wheatley Tops 1,000

Tyrone Wheatleybecame the 13th player in Michigan history to rush for over 1,000 yards in a single season with his performance today. Wheatleygained 86 yards on 14 carries (6.1 avg.) boost his season totals to 1022 yards on 151 carries (6.8 avg.) and 10 rushing touchdowns. Wheatleynow has 1570 rushing yards on 237 carries (a Michigan career record 6.61 avg.) and 19 rushing touchdowns on his career. Wheatleyalso had two receptions for 55 yards including a fifty-yard touchdown reception on a screen pass. Wheatleynow has 14 total touchdowns this season (tied for the sixth best single season total in Michigan history) and 23 career total touchdowns (tied for 13th on Michigan's career list).

Turnover Story

Michigan turned the ball over to the Illini six times today (four lost fumbles and two interceptions), the most turnovers by a Michigan team since the Wolverines turned the ball over seven times (all interceptions) in a 17-11 loss at Michigan State in 1987. The last time Michigan lost four fumbles was earlier this year when the Wolverines fumbled four times in a 35-3 win over Oklahoma State. Prior to this season Michigan had not lost four fumbles in a game since a 40-27 win over Wisconsin in 1976. Michigan's 10 fumbles are the second most by a Wolverine team in school history. The most fumbles ever by a Michigan team were 12 in a 13-9 loss to Illinois in 1946.

Illinois Notes

Jason Verduzcobecame the 8th quarterback in Big Ten history to top 7,000 career passing yards. Verduzcocompleted 25 of 38 passes for 192 yards to lift his career passing yardage total to 7128 yards. Verduzco's performance moved him past former Illini Tony Eason into seventh place on the Big Ten career passing chart, and into second place on the Illinois career passing yardage list.

Offense Still Potent

Michigan's offense continues to roll up yards at a record-setting pace. Today, the Wolverines amassed 523 yards of total offense (245 rushing and 278 passing) on 76 plays (6.9 yards/play). For the season, Michigan now has 4849 yards of total offense on 747 plays (484.9 yards per game, 6.5 yards per play). Michigan's 6.9 yards per play would establish a new team single season record, as would the 484.9 yards of total offense per game.

Michigan's Record Winning Streak Ends

Today's tie with Illinois ended Michigan's Big Ten record conference winning streak at 19 games. The Wolverines are now unbeaten in their last 20 Big Ten games. The Big Ten record for most consecutive conference games without a loss is 22 games, set by Michigan (21-0-1 from 1901-1905).

Elezovic Boots Career-Long Field Goal

Peter Elezovic's 39-yard, game tying field goal was the longest field goal of his Michigan career. Elezovic's previous career long was a 33-yard field goal against Indiana earlier this season. This season, Elezovichas converted on six of 10 field goal attempts.
