# COACHES POST-GAME QUOTES

# MICHIGAN STATE HEAD COACH GEORGE PERLES

On the game, in general:

"We played a lousy first half. If we could just play the way we did in the second half, then we'd have something pretty good. Michigan is too good to spot 28 points, they're too good to spot even 14 points."

"When you play on emotions, anything is likely to happen ... I expected emotions to run today."

"We really didn't have any good field position today; we got backed up on the kickoffs, and we also had some penalties. We were lucky to get that early interception."

On Tyrone Wheatley:

"Wheatley is a great running back. He can see the holes up front, and then he makes holes for himself in the secondary. He'll be everyones All-American, and is certainly quite deserving. He's a big, strong running back, and the credit goes to him."

On the punt return for a touchdown (Alexander's):

"They had a chance to bring it back on the side where we had one man blocking two people."

On Michigan:

"Their whole team is impressive offensively and defensively. Wheatley did a great job on offense, and they had a swarming defense. They play as a team, they keep going, there's no telling where they'll be ranked."

# MICHIGAN HEAD COACH GARY MOELLER

On the win in general:

"Number one, it's good to win, but it wasn't the way I'd have written the script."

"The penalties hurt us, the game should not be played like that, we can't afford penalties."

On comparyative play in the second half:

"I didn't want to risk anything and give them a quick score. Once they know you're going to run, they can shut you down."

On having a 2-0 start, and leading the Big Ten:

"We have to control what we do. We have to win and improve, keeping our concentration. I know we have a lot of work ahead of us."

On not delivering a death blow (as U-M has in last couple games):
"We were playing good defense, I hoped to get field position, and again not
do anything to give them (opponents) a quick score. Our running backs did a
great job holding onto the ball."

On tailback Ricky Powers (not playing versus MSU):

"Ricky (Powers) wanted to play, and I wanted him to play, but why put him in the second half and maybe have him go downhill (with his leg injury). I want him to start back fresh."

### Michigan vs. Michigan State POST-GAME NÖTES

Michigan Sets New NCAA Single Game Attendance Record

Today's attendance of 106,788 established a new NCAA single game attendance record, breaking the old record of 106,255 set in Michigan's 18-15 loss to Ohio State on Nov. 17, 1979 at Michigan Stadium. Today's game marked the 107th consecutive game at Michigan Stadium with a crowd in excess of 100,000, was the 47th consecutive sellout at Michigan Stadium, and was the 45th consecutive sellout in the Michigan-Michigan State series.

Alexander The Great

Derrick Alexanderhad an outstanding day today, collecting 147 all-purpose yards. A majority of those yards came on a 79-yard punt return for a touchdown. Alexander's punt return was the tenth longest punt return in Michigan history and the longest punt return of Alexander's career. The last time a Michigan player returned a punt for a touchdown was Desmond Howard's 93-yard touchdown return in Michigan's 31-3 win over Ohio State last season. Howard's 93-yard punt return ranks as the longest in Michigan history. For the game, Alexander rolled up 108 yards on four punt returns, the third highest single game punt return yardage total in Michigan history. George Hoey set the Michigan record for single game punt return yardage with 140 yards in punt returns against Minnesota in 1967. Tripp Welborne holds second place with 117 yards in punt returns against Indiana in 1990. In addition to his 108 yards on punt returns, Alexander gained 34 yards on two receptions and gained five yards on two carries.

Wheatley Leads Wolverine Ground Assault

For the second consecutive week, Tyrone Wheatley led Michigan's rushing attack. Wolverines gained 294 yards on the ground against MSU, most of which came from Wheatley For the game, Wheatley gained 172 yards on 28 carries (6.1 avg.) and scored two rushing touchdowns. Wheatley, Michigan's leading rusher this season, has gained 468 yards on 60 carries (7.8 avg.) and scored six rushing touchdowns (eight total touchdowns this season). Wheatley's performance today lifted him past 1,000 career rushing yards. Wheatley now has 1,016 career rushing yards and 15 career rushing touchdowns (17 career total touchdowns). Jesse Johnson contributed significantly to the Michigan running game, gaining 72 yards on 17 carries and scoring his first rushing TD of the season. Johnson has now gained 300 yards on 67 carries this season.

Lyons Sets MSU Single Game Record Michigan State tight end Mitch Lyons set a Spartan single game record for receptions by grabbing 12 passes against the Wolverines. Lyons broke Andre Rison's MSU single game record of 11 receptions set in the Spartans' 17-14 loss to Indiana in 1986. Lyons gained 119 yards on his 12 receptions.

MSU In No Rush

For the fourth consecutive week, the Michigan defense held its opponent to under 100 rushing yards, limiting the Spartans to 60 yards on the ground today. This season Michigan has held MSU, Iowa (77 yards), Houston (52 yards), and Oklahoma State (67 yards) to less than 100 rushing yards. Since the start of Gary Moeller's reign in 1990, the Michigan defense has held 16 opponents to less than 100 yards on the ground (MSU, Iowa, Houston, and Oklahoma State this season; Illinois, MSU, Iowa, Notre Dame, and Boston College in 1991; Mississippi, Illinois, Purdue, Iowa, Wisconsin, Maryland, and UCLA in 1990). Since 1990, Michigan is 15-1 in games in which the opposition has gained under 100 rushing yards. Michigan's opponents are averaging 98.6 rushing yards per game this season.

Second Quarter Scoring

The Wolverines rolled up 21 second quarter points this afternoon, continuing their dominance in the second quarter of this season's games. Michigan has now scored 87 points in the second quarter this year, representing 43.5% of Michigan's 200 points scored this season. Additionally, the Wolverine defense has limited its opponents to only nine second quarter points this year.

Grbac Nears 'M' All-Time Record Elvis Groac climbed closer to Michigan's career passing yardage record today. Grbac completed 11 of 19 passes for 111 yards, moving his career totals to 432 of 700 for 5,274 yards. Grbac is now 176 passing yards behind Jim Harbaugh's Michigan career record of 5,163 career passing yards set in 1983-86.
