# **GAME NOTES**

Michigan vs. Illinois

100,000+ streak hits 130 games

Michigan's streak of consecutive games with over 100,000 in attendance at Michigan Stadium reached 130 games with today's announced crowd of 105,992. The streak began on Nov. 8, 1975 against Purdue, and is now in its 22nd season. The last time Michigan failed to draw at least 100,000 fans to a home game occured on Oct. 25, 1975, when 93,857 fans saw the Wolverines defeat Indiana, 55-7. The attendance of 105,992 was the third highest for a Michigan opener, behind 106,138 vs. Notre Dame in 1991 and 106,098 vs. Notre Dame in 1987.

End of an era

The ending of today's game brings to a close a 73 year streak in which Illinois and Michigan have met every season since 1924. In the 73 games, Michigan led the series 53-18-2, and has a 60-20-2 overall edge over Illinois. The Wolverines and Illini will next meet in Champaign on Oct. 23, 1999.

Off to a hot start

Today's kickoff temperature of 83° marked the 20th time since 1950 that the Wolverines played in temperatures over 80°. Michigan holds a record of 17-3 under such conditions, including a 20-17 win over Washington State on Sept. 10, 1983, when the temperature at kickoff was 91 degrees.

Remy hits the second century mark

With his eight points (two field goals and two extra points) in today's game, senior placekicker **Remy Hamilton** has 205 for his career. He becomes the ninth Wolverine to score 200 points, and currently is in eighth place (needs five points to pass **All Haji-Sheikh** who scored 210 points for the Wolverines from 1979-82). Today, Hamilton surpassed **Rick Leach**, who scored 204 points for the Wolverines from 1975-78.

Look both ways

Sophomore cornerback **Charles Woodson**, the 1995 Big Ten Freshman of the Year, ran a 57-yard reverse on his first offensive touch, which led to a 27-yard field goal that gave Michigan a 10-5 lead.

Safety check

Illinois' second quarter safety was the it's first since Oct. 16, 1993, when lowa fumbled a pitch out of the end zone for two Illinois points. The previous safety against the Wolverines occured when Todd Collins was downed in the end zone by Ohio State in Columbus on Nov. 19, 1994.

Odds and ends

Scott Des sbach's 72-yard touchdown scaper in the second quarter was the third longest ever by a Michigan quarterback and the 13th longest run by an Illini opponent...Illinois OLB Famous Hulbert recorded his first career sack, while CB James Williams and OLB Ryan Murphy each registered their first career field goal block ...Michigan has now won 15 straight conference openers and 28 of the last 29...The Wolverines have won their last four openers and have not lost a season debut since 1990 (Notre Dame, 28-24)...The Wolverines have won both games they have played in August...DE David Bowens picked up a career high three sacks in today's contest.

# FROM THE MICHIGAN PRESS ROOM

Head Coach Lloyd Carr:

(On the game in general...) "We're happy to get the win. I want to credit Lou Tepper for getting his team ready, they played a hard, physical game."

(On the running game...) "Our inability to run in the first half put us in a hole. But in the second half, it was our ability to run that allowed us to move the ball. We've got some time to get better."

(On the key point of the game...) "Obviously the biggest series was our goal line stand when they had a chance to take the lead."

(On the play of Scott Dreisbach...) "He was tentative in the first two or three series and he rushed a few passes, but when he completed a couple, that was important on the field goal drive at the end of the first half. But remember, he has been out nine games and he may have been a bit nervous."

(On using Charles Woodson on offense...) "It's the nature of the game now with all the limitations on the number of players...you have to utilize players who have special abilities."

(More on the game in general...) "The kids did a good job despite the letdown early, and then they came out and played well in the second half."

(On Clarence Williams...) "I liked the fact that he ran better in the fourth quarter than he did in the first...he has high energy and is always going. He wants to be the best he can be. He has a passion for the game."

(On the flea-flicker/lateral pass from Butterfield to Dreisbach...) "For a play that didn't work, it woke everybody up."

(On trick plays in general...) "We try to have some wrinkles in our offense."

(When asked if Jarrett Irons could play better...) "(Jarrett) Irons played great. If he plays like that, he'll have a great season and we'll have a great defense. If he can play better than that? I'll make it a challenge."

## FROM THE ILLINOIS PRESS ROOM

**Head Coach Lou Tepper:** 

(On the effort from both teams starting in August...) "Both teams played with a lot of effort. Both defenses got worn out in the second half."

(On the play of the special teams...) "Special teams gave us two very special plays...two blocked field goals and good field position on returns."

(On the offense...) "Our offense used the strong mix and kept Michigan off-balance in the first half. We needed stops in the second half and didn't get them."

(On this game being the season opener...) "When you play an opening game, the offenses have to adjust more to the defenses."

(On whether or not Illinois played conservatively at the end of the first half...) "We chose to throw and move the ball down the field as much as we liked. We weren't being cautious, but we wanted to get some points on the board."
