Game Notes

ANOTHER 100,000

For the 141st consecutive time Michigan Stadium has played host to a crowd in excess of 100,000. The 106,577 in attendance represented the second largest crowd for a Michigan-Minnesota football contest, and the second largest Homecoming crowd (both to the 1992 Minnesota game).

CARR PERFECT ON HOMECOMING

With the 24-3 win over Minnesota, Head Coach Lloyd Carr improved his Homecoming record to 3-0 and U-M's record on Homecoming to 74-23. Michigan also retained the Little Brown Jug for the 11th straight season.

STEELE DRIVES 'EM BACK

With his eight-yard sack late in the first quarter, fifth-year senior defensive end Glen Steele (Ligonier, IN) moved up on the career sack and tackle for loss lists. Steele's 40 tackles for loss gives him sole possession of third, ahead of Will Carr (1993-96) and Jason Horn (1992-95). The play gave Steele 173 career tackle for loss yards (6th) and 123 career sack yards (6th).

MR. VERSATILE

Against Minnesota, junior All-American Charles Woodson (Freemont, OH) continued to turn heads. With the Wolverines trailing 3-0, Woodson took a reverse from Chris Howard (River Ridge, LA) on the first play of the second quarter and scampered 33 yards for a touchdown. The run was Woodson's second touchdown of the season (other was a 10-yard pass versus Baylor), second career rushing score, and fourth career overall TD. Both of his touchdowns have held up as the game's winning score. For the game, Woodson saw action on 65 plays (45 defensive, 14 offensive, and six special teams). The 14 offensive plays marked a career-high, surpassing the seven versus Northwestern earlier in the season. Woodson collected three tackles, 63 all-purpose yards (25 return, 33 rushing, and five receiving), and a 15-yard pass interference call on a 40-yard toss down field.

CAMPBELL, SHEA HAVE CAREER DAYS

Fourth-year junior tight-end Mark Campbell (Clawson, MI) turned in a career day in the Minnesota contest. Entering the game his career-bests were three receptions (vs. UCLA in 1996) and 35 receiving yards (at Boston College in 1996). Against Minnesota, Campbell caught three balls for 44 yards. With 7:58 left in the half, Campbell caught his first career touchdown pass, a 12-yard reception from Brian Griese (Miami, FL), giving U-M a 14-3 lead. Michigan's other back-up tight end, Aaron Shea (Ottawa, IL) corralled three receptions for 51 yards, also career bests. His previous highs were 2 catches and 25 receiving yards.

THOMAS ATTACK

Freshman tailback Anthony Thomas (Winnfield, LA) made a number of big plays for the Wolverines. With 9:09 left in the second quarter Thomas caught a Griese pass for a career-long 28 yards, leading to U-M's second touchdown. The freshman returned the second half opening kick 33 yards, the longest kick-off return for Michigan this season. Then, Thomas finished Michigan's second drive of the second half with a 29-yard touchdown run. It was his third touchdown (all rushing) of the season. For the game, Thomas accumulated 39 rushing yards (on 10 carries) and 43 receiving yards (on three receptions).

A BLOCK THAT COUNTS

After having a blocked punt called back last week at Michigan State, U-M came back with another block in the Minnesota game. With 1:02 left in the first half, DiAllo Johnson (Detroit, MI) blocked a punt, which was recovered by freshman Jake Frysinger (Grosse Ile, MI) at the Minnesota eight-yard line. It was U-M's first blocked punt since Illinois on Sept. 2, 1995.

SAUTER, WILLIAMS SET MINNESOTA MARKS

With his eight pass attempts in the game, fifth-year senior quarterback Cory Sauter (Hutchinson, MN) set a Minnesota school record with 881 pass attempts. The previous mark was 876 held by

Marquel Fleetwood (1989-92). Lamanzer Williams (Ypsilanti, MI), a fifth-year senior defensive end, set a school record with 15 tackles for loss in a single season with his fourth quarter tackle for loss. Steve Neils set the previous mark of 14 in the 1973 season.

OTHER GOPHER NOTES

Sophomore Jimmy Wyrick's (De Soto, TX) second quarter interception was the first of his career ... Senior wideout Tutu Atwell (Miami, FL) extended his pass catching streak to 33 consecutive games.
