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Notes and Records

- Lloyd Carr is only the second coach to win games in three consecutive seasons against Joe Paterno. Previously, only Bill Curry of Alabama had won three straight from 1987-1989.
- Penn State had 20 rushes for 7 yards today, both record lows during the time that Joe Paterno has been head coach. The previous lows were 19 yards rushing vs. Alabama in the 1979 Sugar Bowl and 26 rushing attempts in 1999 at Ohio State. The prior record low rushing yardage in the regular season for the Lions under Coach Paterno was 35 yards in 1966 at UCLA.
- Twenty-five PSU seniors played their final game in Beaver Stadium today. This group has a cumulative record of 38-10.
- Until today's game, Penn State had not trailed by more than 7 points in any game this season. At Purdue, the Lions fell behind by 7 points on two occasions.
- The visiting team has now won 5 of 7 meetings between the two schools.
- This is the 6th time in 7 meetings between PSU and Michigan that a team has had a 10-0 lead. In the those 6 meetings, the team with the 10-0 lead has won 5 times.
- The last time that Penn State lost consecutive games at home by 4 points or less was in 1992 against Miami (FL) 17-14 and against Boston College 35-32.
- The last time that PSU lost two consecutive games in November was in 1988.
- Matt Senneca's 33 yard punt in the 2nd quarter was his first career punt.
- Bruce Branch's 2 punt returns this year for touchdowns ties a school record for most punt returns for touchdowns in a season. The record was previously set by Jimmy Cefalo in 1977 and tied by O.J. McDuffie in 1991.
- Branch also tied the career punt return for touchdown record with his 3rd career punt return for a touchdown. He tied O.J. McDuffie, who also had 3 career punt returns for touchdowns.
- The 53 yard kickoff return by Michigan's Walter Cross in the 2nd quarter was the longest allowed by the Lions this season.
- Derek Fox's 2nd quarter interception was his third pick this year, tying him with Askari Adams for the team lead.
- James Boyd's 2nd quarter interception was also his third pick of the year, tying him with Adams and Fox for the team lead with three.
- Dave Royer's 35 yard punt in the second quarter was his first career punt.
- Penn State had 3 scoring drives today of under 3:00, giving them 37 on the year. In addition, the Lions had 1 scoring drive that took less than 2:00, giving them 23 this season.
- The Nittany Lions had 3 plays from scrimmage of over 20 yards in today's game, giving them 63 for the year.
- LaVar Arrington's four tackles-for-loss ties a career high set last year at Pittsburgh. In addition, Arrington now has 39 tackles for loss, good enough for 6th place on the PSU career list.
- Chafie Fields's 7 catches today are a career high. His previous high was 6 set in 1997 at Illinois.

Travis Senneca's two field goals today gives him 45 and ties him with Brett Conway for second place on the

- Kevin Thompson's completions (19) tied his career-high, his 37 attempts were a career-high and his 263 yards were second-best of his career.
- Forney's 9 points today give him 250 for his career, moving him ahead of Lydell Mitchell (246) into 3rd place on the PSU career scoring list.
- The interception by Bhawoh Jue was his first career interception return for a touchdown.
- Today's game marked the second time this year that the Nittany Lions scored a touchdown on offense, on defense, and by special teams. (vs. Indiana, 9/25)
- The Nittany Lions had 40 pass attempts today, tied for 10th highest all time under Joe Paterno. Previously, the Lions had 40 attempts against Stanford in the 1993 Blockbuster Bowl.
- Brandon Short had 13 tackles today, giving him 261 on his career, moving him into 6th place on the Penn State career tackles list, behind Shane Conlan (1983-86). In addition, Short had 2 tackles for loss, giving him 50 for his career, moving him into a tie for 17th on the Big Ten career list.
- Short's 13 tackles today are a career high. His previous high 12 at Illinois earlier this season.
- With his one tackle for loss today, Courtney Brown now has 66 in his career, tying him with Mike Vrabel of Ohio State (1993-96) for fifth place in the Big Ten annals.
- Eddie Drummond's 8 receptions today tied his career high for most receptions in a single game, set earlier this season at Miami (FL).
- Michigan has now won 11 of its last 12 games vs. AP top ten opponents, and is 17-6-1 against AP top ten teams in the 1990's.
- Today's game was the 11th time that Lloyd Carr faced a top-ten opponent, and is now 10-1 in those games.
- Michigan's Anthony Thomas's 127 yards were his 12th career 100 yard game, and was his 6th this season. His rushing touchdown today was his 15th which ties himself (1998) for second on the Michigan single-season touchdown list. The record was 19 set by Ron Johnson in 1968.
- Anthony Thomas became only the third opposing running back to gain 100 yards in a game against the Lions in the last 23 games.
- Anthony Thomas's touchdown was his 35th rushing touchdown in his career, good enough for 2nd place on the Michigan career rushing touchdown list. The record is 47 by Tyrone Wheatley (1991-94).
- Sophomore WR David Terrell's had a 6 receptions for 133 yards, which is a career best in yardage. This was his 4th 100 yard receiving game of the season.
- Senior WR Marcus Knight's two touchdowns were the first time in his career that he had two touchdowns in a single game.
- Michigan's receiving combination of Knight and Terrell has 1,639 yards for the season, good enough for 3rd place on the Michigan single-season tandem receiving list. This is 46 yards short of the best Michigan combination ever of 1,685 by Mercury Hayes and Amani Toomer in the 1994 season.
- Drew Henson's first quarter reception was the first of his career. It was also DiAllo Johnson's first career completion.

Michigan Head Coach Lloyd Carr

"I think it was a great game with great plays. Both sides played great defense and had great effort and intensity. For us this was a very special victory."

"I thought (Penn State) played awfully hard and there was no let down that I could see."

"Both quarterbacks showed incredible toughness. I think both got hit as hard as they could be hit and came back and made some great plays."

"I think the key to the first half was we were able to run the ball successfully. We struggled a bit with the running in the second half."

"That Penn State defense is legit."

"I've felt from the beginning of the year that we had an outstanding front seven (on defense). Our problems have come from having to retool our secondary the past few years."
