/d/ → /t/ / [-voiced] _____ | (d or t; d in citation)

Morphology:

Roots: gör ‘see’ aç ‘open’ yet ‘reach’ kır ‘break’ yaz ‘write’

Suffixes (all inflectional):

1. Passive -il
2. Negative -me /_C ~ -m /_V
3. Perfect -miş
4. ‘should’ -meliy
5. Future -ecek
6. Progressive -iyor /_C (NB: the /o/ does *not* harmonize)
7. Past tense -di /_C ~ -d /_V
8. Interrogative -mi /_C ~ -miy /_V

Subject Agreement:

	Singular	Plural
1 st	-im	-iz
3 rd	-Ø	-ler

Order of Morphemes (not all combinations occur):

Root + 1 + 2 + 3 + 4 + 5 + 6 + 3rd Su + 7 + 8 + 1st Su

Note:

- 2 + 6 = *müiyor* in #6, but *mayor* in #39
This is contradictory; is #39 a typo?
