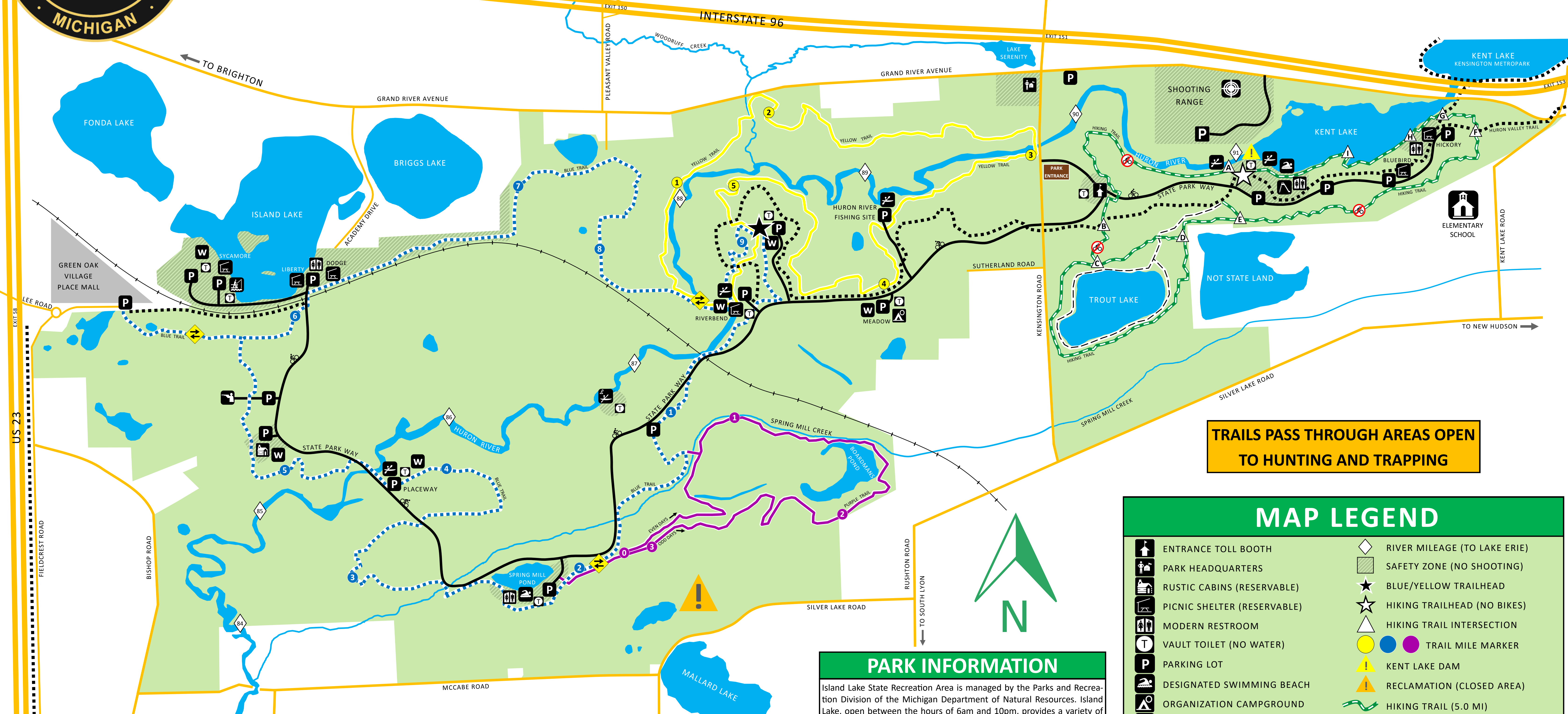




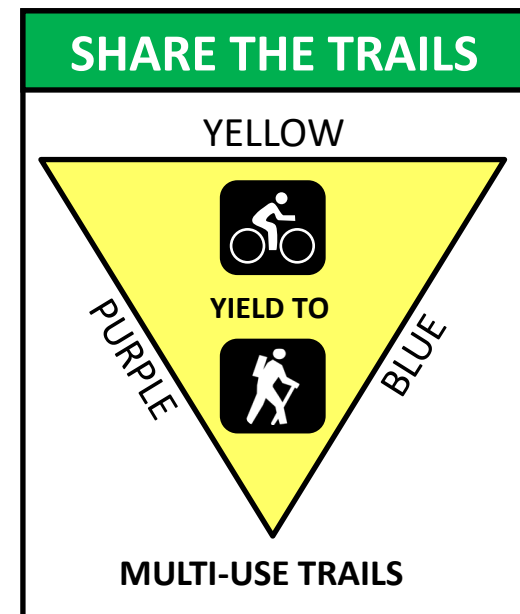
ISLAND LAKE STATE RECREATION AREA PARK MAP

PARK INFORMATION
 Island Lake State Recreation Area is managed by the Parks and Recreation Division of the Michigan Department of Natural Resources. Island Lake, open between the hours of 6am and 10pm, provides a variety of recreational opportunities to more than 1 million guests every year.
 Lodging and camping amenities are available at Island Lake's rustic cabins, rustic canoe-in campsites, and organization campground. Many visitors spend their summers flocking to the sandy, designated beaches as well as other bodies of water throughout the park. Connecting communities throughout the state, the Great Lake-to-Lake Trail, also runs through the park, traversing from South Haven to Port Huron.
 Island Lake is home to one of the nations safest shooting ranges and offers sporting clays, trap shooting, and a rifle/pistol range. The range is open year-round for park visitors to enjoy.
